- The following staff and businesses are being honored by The Arc of Maryland at their annual convention in May; Stephanie Bell, Assistant Director of Quality Assurance for outstanding administration/program management, Maisy Chenoweth, outstanding direct care staff person, Chris Anderson, Volunteer of the Year, and Carroll County Times for Community Media Excellence. - Jill Snyder, program coordinator and Stephanie Bell, have been selected to participate in the Maryland Council of Executives of The Arc (MCEArc) advanced leadership training series.
- Congratulations to Alicia Philips and Krissy Heuer for successfully completing the FACT group Leadership Academy.
- All renovation projects at 180 Kriders Church Road are complete.
- The Art of The Arc was a very successful venture on many levels. The Arc artists earned a total of \$1,800. One individual sold over \$300 of her artwork.
- We have initiated a pilot project with our health services area and IT vendor to move towards a more efficient and paperless process. Early indications are positive and we are hoping to include more aspects of our operations.
- The Arc of Maryland Annual Convention is Friday, May 21, 2010 at the Crowne Plaza Hotel in Timonium. Carroll County will be well represented.
- The annual Drivers and Assistants Appreciation Breakfast will be held at the Best Western Hotel on Friday, June 11<sup>th</sup> starting at 9:00 A.M. You are all cordially invited.
